ACKNOWLEDGEMENT LETTER: HAZARDOUS WASTE TRANSPORTER WITHIN THE **EKURHULENI MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES**

The above matter has reference:

The background information and Hazardous Waste Transporter Certificate which was submitted by WasteServe Environmental Solution in respect of the abovementioned application and received by the Ekurhuleni Waste Management Services Department has reference.

The following has been reached in support of your application:

- 1. The Ekurhuleni Municipality hereby acknowledges WasteServe Environmental Solution as hazardous waste transporter operating within the Ekurhuleni Municipal jurisdiction.
- 2. This acknowledgement letter does not (in any form) exempt WasteServe Environmental Solution to formally consult relevant Provincial or National Authorities for applicable and or required licenses, permits, or mandatory approvals pertinent to the category of service.

3. No person may, without or not in accordance with the council 's written approval of

conditions, remove special industrial hazardous, medical and infectious refuse from

premises at which it has been generated.

4. All hazardous, medical or infectious refuse may only be transported in accordance with

the requirement of the council, with the focus on the type of vehicle, its making, and the

way it is manufactured, safety procedures and hygiene and documentation regarding the

origin, transport and disposal of such refuse.

5. The person referred in section 18 (1) of EMM By-Law shall inform the council, at such

intervals as the council may stipulate, having regard to the information to be given to the

council in terms of that section, of the removal of special industrial, hazardous, medical

or infectious refuse, the identity of the remover, the date of such removal, the quantity and

consumption of the special industrial, hazardous, medical or infectious refuse remove.

6. The council shall not give consent in terms of sub section (1) of EMM By-Law unless it is

satisfied that the person applying for such consent is so competent and has the equipment

to remove the special ,industrial, hazardous, medical and infectious, refuse and complies

with the condition laid down by the council.

7. No person shall dispose of any infectious refuse by incinerating it unless the council 'prior

written permission has been given to incinerate such refuse.

Therefore this acknowledgement letter may not by any means be regarded nor serve as a

license nor a permit for services rendered by WasteServe Environmental Solution.

Hope you will consider the above in order.
